- Receive complete 20 hour orientation and ongoing training and support to ensure your success;

- Receive a living allowance stipend of \$2,000 for grant year April 1, 2010 to March 31, 2011 to help defray expenses;
- Earn an educational award of \$1,250 for lifelong learning opportunities; and most importantly
- Experience the satisfaction of knowing your services have helped to improve the quality of life of family caregivers and helped seniors live independently in their own neighborhoods and communities.
